

Rekero Camp – Masai Mara National Reserve








Rekero will be closing on 1 March 2024 for a refurbishment, this will be completed in time for high season 2024.






After a 3-month closure, Naboisho re-opened in June 2023, with a complete rebuild of all guest tents and upgrades to shared areas.

# TRANS-MARA DAY TRIPS




As of November 2022, we no longer offer trans-Mara day trips and excursions from our camps.

Due to **increased human pressure on habitats and wildlife**, we no longer feel it is appropriate to promote activities and day excursions that require guests staying inside the conservancies to leave them for the Mara Reserve, or vice versa.


The experiences enjoyed at Rekero in the main reserve and Naboisho and Encounter Camp in the Mara Naboisho Conservancy are distinct and unique, with the **benefit of a two-centre safari far outweighing the experience achievable through a day trip excursion** to either location.

Guests may still book a trans-Mara excursion by pre-booking an exclusive use private vehicle, but they are advised of the negative impact to the region and the increasingly compromised experience. Balloon safaris will continue to be offered and any pre-booked excursions will be


